WHAT IS AN EO CLASSROOM?

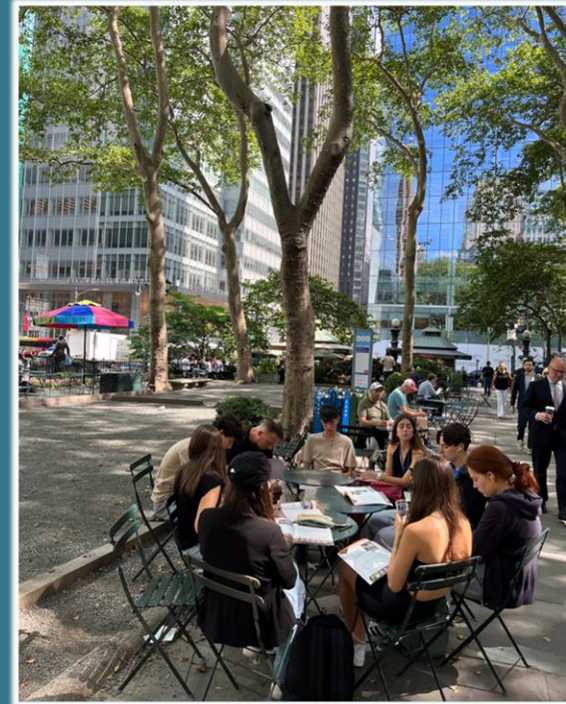
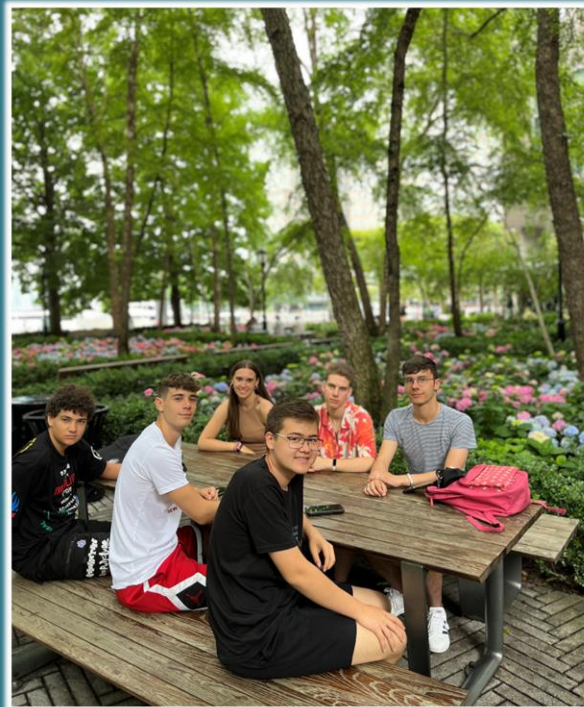
Locations are carefully chosen based on comfort, ease of access, points of interest close by, proximity of public restrooms, etc.

THE CLASSES

- ❖ Teachers utilize the coursebook, supplementary materials, mini-whiteboards and technology (iPads, smartphones) to further engage students.
- ❖ Students complete regular homework, participate in pair work, discussion, presentations... just like in a traditional language course.
 - ❖ International phone plan and headset recommended: teachers and students join a Whatsapp group to stay connected
- ❖ Level of English tested before arrival via a multiple choice test and writing test.
